**N.J.A.C. 16:75 – New Jersey Transit Bus Allocation Program Guidelines and Procedures**

**Summary**

The proposed new rules re-promulgate expired rules governing the leasing of buses to private motorbus carriers for the operation of regular route bus service. In accordance with the sunset provisions of Executive Order No. 66 (1978), N.J.A.C. 16:75 expired on February 4, 2007 and, therefore, New Jersey Transit Corporation (NJ TRANSIT) proposes this chapter as new rules.

N.J.A.C 16:75 is designed to provide guidelines and procedures governing the allocation and lease of buses to carriers pursuant to N.J.S.A. 27:25-5 (h) and (k).

Subchapter 1 describes the purpose of these rules and the applicable definitions.

Subchapter 2 sets forth the guidelines and criteria to be followed in determining the eligibility of private bus carriers and the regular route bus services operated by the carriers for the allocation of buses, the procedure to be used to handle the request of a carrier for a determination of eligibility and guidelines regarding the retirement of buses and disposal procedures.

Subchapter 3 sets forth the procedures to be used to determine the allocation of buses to carriers.

Subchapter 4 describes the requirements for an agreement between NJ TRANSIT and the carrier for the lease of buses, compliance requirements and conditions regarding the use of the equipment leased to the carrier.
