Bus Route No. 22

- Bus Route No. 22 will no longer serve Cliffside Park or Fairview. All trips will now end at 90th Street in North Bergen. Cliffside Park & Fairview customers traveling south of 90th Street in North Bergen must now use Bus Route nos. 156, 159 or 181. Transfer at either 90th Street or 49th Street to Bus Route No. 22 to complete your trip.
- **For a faster trip between Union City and Hoboken, transfer to the Hudson-Bergen Light Rail at Bergenline Avenue Station and save 15-20 minutes in travel time.**
- New Bus Route No. 22X will be created for former Bus Route No. 89 customers who travel between Union City and Hoboken via Bergenline or New York avenues. **See a 22/22X timetable for more details.**

Bus Route No. 23

- Bus Route No. 23 now offers new direct and frequent service to Port Imperial Light Rail Station & Ferry Terminal in Weehawken.
- **For a faster trip between Boulevard East and Hoboken, transfer to the Hudson-Bergen Light Rail at Port Imperial Station and save 15-20 minutes in travel time.**
- Bus Route No. 23 service between Boulevard East and Hoboken is being reduced. **See a 23 timetable for more details.**
- Bus Route No. 23 will no longer serve Lincoln Harbor. Customers traveling to Lincoln Harbor from Boulevard East or Hoboken must now transfer from Bus Route No. 23 to the Hudson-Bergen Light Rail at Port Imperial or Hoboken stations to complete their trip.
- **Former NY Waterway Boulevard East shuttle customers, should take Bus Route No. 23 for travel to the NY Waterway-Port Imperial Ferry Terminal.**

Bus Route No. 86

- Bus Route No. 86 will operate along Park Avenue at all times. Bus Route No. 86 will no longer operate along Bergenline Avenue between 31st Street in Union City and 77th Street in North Bergen. **See the Bus Route**

Bus Route No. 86 (continued)

- **nos. 22, 84, 156, 159, or 181 timetables for alternate service along Bergenline Ave.**
- Service on Bus Route No. 86 during the mid-day, evening and weekends will only operate between Newport Centre in Jersey City and the Hudson-Bergen Light Rail Bergenline Avenue Station in Union City via 48th Street.
- **Customers traveling to Exchange Place or Pavonia-Newport, transfer to the Hudson-Bergen Light Rail at Bergenline Avenue Station and save 20-30 minutes in travel time.**

Bus Route No. 89

- Bus Route No. 89 will be rerouted south of 48th Street to operate along Park Avenue in Union City and Washington Street in Hoboken. This replaces Bus Route No. 181 in this area. With this change, Bus Route No. 89 will now operate 7 days-a-week, with new mid-day and evening service every hour.
- Select weekday and all weekend service will be extended to 90th Street in North Bergen.
- Bus Route No. 89 will no longer travel between Union City and Hoboken via Bergenline & New York avenues. Customers in this area must now use Bus Route nos. 22X or 22. **See a 22/22X timetable for more details.**

Bus Route No. 181

- Bus Route No. 181 will operate only between the Hudson-Bergen Light Rail Bergenline Avenue Station in Union City and the GW Bridge Bus Station. Transfer at 49th Street to Bus Route nos. 22, 22X, & 89 for connecting Hoboken service to complete your trip.
- **For faster service between Union City and Hoboken, transfer to the Hudson-Bergen Light Rail at Bergenline Avenue Station and save 15-20 minutes in travel time.**
- For Bus Route No. 181 customers traveling between Union City and Hoboken along Park Avenue and Washington Street, you must now use Bus Route nos. 22 or 89. **See a 22/22X or an 89 timetable for more details.**

Fare and Ticket Information

Bus Route Nos. 22, 23, 86, and 89 are exact fare lines. The driver carries no cash and will not make change. One dollar bills are accepted.

Bus Route No. 181 is a full service line. The driver will make change. \$1, \$5, \$10, \$20 bills & most coins are accepted. Drivers are not required to accept bills larger than a \$20 bill. For your convenience, we recommend purchasing your tickets in advance or having exact change.

Travel Flexibility

You can use your NJ TRANSIT 2-Zone (or higher) monthly bus pass for any Hudson-Bergen Light Rail trip at no additional charge during the period it is valid.

Customers may purchase a one-zone transfer for \$.60 from their NJ TRANSIT bus operator that will be valid for connection onto Hudson-Bergen Light Rail. Customers purchasing tickets through Hudson-Bergen Light Rail TVMs may purchase a one-zone transfer during the transaction, valid for connection to a one-zone bus ride.
